

6. Petitioner is not subject to the registration requirements of chapter 62 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure.

7. Petitioner includes with this Petition a legible and complete set of fingerprints on a fingerprint card format acceptable to the Texas Department of Public Safety and the Federal Bureau of Investigation. (See Exhibit A.)

8. Petitioner requests the Court to grant a change of Petitioner's name to **my new name**.

9. Petitioner requests the Court to grant to **my dead name** a gender identification correction from male to female.

10. The reason for the requested change is that Petitioner has undergone psychotherapy to determine Petitioner's true gender identity and it was determined that Petitioner's gender is female. Petitioner has undergone hormone replacement therapy and has had a number of significant physical changes that are irreversible. *See* supporting documentation attached as Exhibit B and incorporated herein for all purposes. As a transsexual person, a gender identification correction is necessary to avoid bias and frustration in the medical and psychological treatment of the Petitioner.

11. Petitioner prays that the Court grant Petitioner's Petition for Change of Name of an Adult and Correct the Gender Designation.

12. Petitioner prays for general relief.
